## QUESTIONS FOR LIFE GROUPS AND PERSONAL REFLECTION

### Personal Life:

1. If we were to join in the song of Revelation 5:9-10 today, what would be your personal reasons for praising Jesus as your Redeemer? Discuss...

### Ponderings:

2. Think about the heavenly imagery of Revelation 4-5, such as the four angelic beings with faces like a lion, ox, man and eagle with six wings and eyes all around, the 24 elders casting their crowns, the thunder and lightning, the vivid colors and precious stones, the Lamb looking as though He had been slain, etc. What are your thoughts about the intense imagery detailed in this vision of Heaven's throne room? How does the resolve of Jesus appearing and taking the scroll impact your initial feeling of the scene? Discuss...
3. What do the titles of Jesus (such as "Lion of Judah" and "Lamb who was slain") tell us about His nature and role in God's plan? Discuss...
4. From chapter 5, what can we learn about worship and adoration of the Lamb that can translate into the way we worship Him today?
5. Discuss the interplay of God's sovereignty and the redemption accomplished by the Lamb in this passage. How does this shape our understanding of salvation?
6. Revelation 5 points toward the final victory of Christ. How does this eschatological perspective give us hope in our current struggles or circumstances? Discuss...

### Promptings:

7. What is one way you can live out the truths found in Revelation 5 this week? How can you demonstrate the redemptive work of Christ in your sphere of influence? Try to be as specific as possible...
