The Big Idea:

Revelation is the unveiling of the person and plan of Jesus Christ. Jesus tells us to "occupy" until He comes (Luke 19), to be alert but not fearful.

1 Timothy 4:1-2

The Spirit clearly says that in later times some will abandon the faith and follow deceiving spirits and things taught by demons. Such teachings come through hypocritical liars, whose consciences have been seared as with a hot iron.
